## Sixth Form Dress Code

Although there is no formal dress code in Sixth Form, we ask students to come dressed sensibly for a working school day in smart casual clothing. Sixth Form students are role models for the younger pupils and ambassadors for the school and should observe the following:

- Hair must be a natural colour i.e. not blue, pink or green etc.
- The only piercing visible should be in your ears.
- Tattoos must not be visible (over 18s)
- Shoes must be sensible for health and safety reasons (no platforms, very high heels or flip flops)
- No offensive slogans or revealing clothing is permitted (including no cropped tops, or strappy vest tops, please be sensible with skirt and short length)
- Jeans should not have excessive rips and holes in (a small rip on the knee is fine)
- Sensible sports clothing is permitted on days where you have sport activities (Please note, if you are competing for the school, you will need school kit as per below)
- No hoods, caps or hats to be worn inside.
- A smarter outfit (blazer and a dress or a shirt with a skirt or tailored trousers) for formal occasions like Open Days, whole school assemblies, prize giving.
